32 Fever Clinics Operational Around Fiji In Response To COVID-19

28/03/2020

There are currently 5 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Fiji. There have been no new cases since Wednesday 25 March.

As of Friday, 27 March, a total of 32 fever clinics have been setup and are fully operational around the country as Fiji ramps up its rapid response to COVID-19.

These clinics are operational from 8:00am until 4:00 pm from Monday to Sunday and are based at strategic locations that can be conveniently accessed by the members of the public.

In an effort to stop the spread of this virus, the Fijian Ministry of Health and Medical Services is encouraging people to visit these clinics should they have a fever or develop any symptoms of COVID-19.

People will not need to make any appointments with the doctors and nurses in these clinics.

Establishment of fever clinics is an integral part of Fijian Government's effort to contain the spread

of the virus.

This is also done to ensure that the vulnerable members of the public are not exposed to the virus in regular hospitals/health centres.

Most of the Clinics are open from 8am-4pm, 7 days a week, with the exception of the following clinics: Punjas Health Centre (Lautoka) and Kamikamica Health Centre (Lautoka) are open from 8am-10pm and the Valelevu Health Centre in Nasinu is open 24 hours.
