PUBLIC NOTICE ON E-PASS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Pursuant to the Public Notice of 24th April 2020 on the above subject, and in a bid to improve on the efficiency and transparency in the management of passes for movement of persons and vehicles during periods of lockdowns or restrictions, the National Emergency Operations Centre is implementing an Electronic Pass Management System (e-Pass). Effective immediately, the following policies and processes shall apply in the issuance of e-Passes.

1. Categories Automatically Eligible and not requiring a Pass

The following categories automatically qualify to move and need not apply for passes:

 Transporters of essential goods (food items, drinking water, fuel, drugs and medical supplies, construction materials)

2. Eligibility to Apply for Passes

The eligibility conditions announced for earlier restrictions shall apply. The eligible categories include:

- Essential service providers (electricity, telecommunications, health workers, water supply, Government infrastructure contractors, uniformed state and private security personnel, currency transport vehicles)
- Government and private business personnel on essential duties
- International NGOs and relief service providers

All requests not meeting the above criteria shall be rejected. For extraordinary circumstances where an organisation does not fall within the approved eligible categories, a request for special consideration should be addressed to the National Coordinator sent to the e-mail address stated in Paragraph 8 below.
