Travel Advisory

In light of the outbreak of Coronavirus in China and its spread to other countries, the Ministry of Information & Communications hereby issues the following travel advisory to the general public:

1. Avoid travel outside Bhutan, both by overland and by air;
2. In the event of unavoidable travel, and to reduce the risk of infection;
 - a) *Avoid close contact with people suffering from respiratory infection, and*
 - b) *Use face masks, gloves and alcohol-based sanitizers while handling passports, documents, luggage etc.*
3. Travelers with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should practice cough etiquette by
 - a) *Maintaining distance;*
 - b) *Covering cough and sneezes with disposable tissues or clothing;*
 - c) *Washing hands with soap and water.*
 - d) *Avoid touching your eyes and mouth.*
 - e) *Follow health advisory issued by the Ministry of Health.*

Tourists and Bhutanese arriving in Bhutan with travel history to infected countries are requested to cooperate with the law enforcement agencies at the point of entry and follow their advice.
