TO AMEND CERTAIN TERMS OF THE PRESIDENT'S PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARATION DATED JANUARY 31, 2020.

TWENTY-FIRST CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2020 CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION NO. 21-117, C.D.1, C.D.2

A RESOLUTION

To amend certain terms of the President's Public Health Emergency Declaration dated January 31, 2020.

- 1 WHEREAS, on January, 31, 2020, the President issued a Public
- 2 Health Emergency Declaration; and
- 3 WHEREAS in accordance to Article X, section 9 of the FSM
- 4 Constitution, Congress within 30 days of the declaration, shall
- 5 convene to revoke, amend or extend the declaration; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Congress is currently convened for its Third Regular
- 7 Session and therefore has the powers under the Constitution to
- 8 revoke, amend or extend the Declaration; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Congress has reviewed the Declaration and the facts
- 10 attending to the Declaration, and has met and conferred with the
- 11 President and has considered the President's requests for
- 12 Congressional action; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated
- 14 States of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 2020, that:
- 1. The authority of the Presidential Declaration of Emergency
- 16 shall be deemed to be pursuant to Article X, section 9 of the
- 17 Constitution not Article IX, section 10 as cited in the
- 18 Declaration of Emergency; and
- 19 2. The Declaration of Emergency of January 31, 2020, is
- 20 hereby extended up to 60 days from the date of the Declaration;

1 and

- 2 3. The President's authority to access the Compact-created
- 3 fund called the Disaster Assistance Emergency Fund (DAEF) is
- 4 hereby revoked, and in lieu thereof, the President is authorized
- 5 to access as much of the Disaster Relief Fund set up under Title
- 6 55 of the Code of the FSM (Annotated) as is necessary up to
- 7 \$700,000, and a full accounting of the expenditures shall be
- 8 submitted to Congress not later than 30 days after the emergency
- 9 is over; and
- 10 4. Notwithstanding any previous authorization, designation,
- 11 or earmarking of said funds in the Disaster Relief Fund the
- 12 President is hereby further authorized to use the proceeds
- 13 available under subsection 3 above in any manner necessary to deal
- 14 with the public health emergency, including the mitigation of
- 15 costs for people affected by the travel ban instituted by the
- 16 Declaration; and
- 5. The President is further authorized, subsequent to the
- 18 adoption of this Resolution, to amend the terms of the travel ban
- 19 instituted by the Declaration, including to reinstate, add or
- 20 remove countries or areas affected by the travel ban, or any
- 21 quarantine requirements, in order to respond effectively and
- 22 efficiently to the evolving situation taking into account the
- 23 burdens and costs associated with said quarantine requirements;
- 24 and
- 25 6. Initially the travel restrictions and quarantine

1 requirements imposed on countries other than China, including 2 those in paragraph (4) of the Declaration, are hereby lifted upon 3 adoption of this Resolution; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the President 4 may reimpose such restrictions and requirements as necessary and at any time thereafter based on World Health Organization 6 guidelines; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President shall disseminate 7 8 widely the Declaration of Emergency as amended by Congress, and any subsequent amendments made by the President pursuant to this 10 Resolution; and 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this
2	resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
3	of Micronesia, the Chief Justice of the FSM Supreme Court, the
4	Governors of Chuuk, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap States, the presiding
5	officers of the four state legislatures, and the heads of the
6	airports in Chuuk, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap.
