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Normalization of daily life and organizational activities begins on May 11th

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With curfews in force in Colombo, Gampaha, Kalutara and Puttalam districts, the normalization of daily life and organizational activities will begin on Monday, May 11

Public and private sector companies should be reopened from Monday to bring normalcy to life and the economy, including the continuation of essential services in these districts. The company leaders have been informed to prepare the necessary plans from now on keeping in view the need for the services. Company leaders must ensure full compliance with the guidelines issued by health officials, including the Director General of Health Services, to control Covid 19 infection when opening and operating companies.

Company leaders can determine the number of employees to be called to service and who to call for service in government agencies, including departments, corporations, and councils. The opening hours of private sector companies have been ordered as 10.00 am.

To control the spread of the virus, people need to stop taking to the streets unnecessarily and gathering elsewhere. The Board of Transport is limited to those traveling in the passenger transport industry on buses and trains.

People other than those who are forced to socialize for work are asked to stay at home to co-operate in the relief of the disease. Anyone should leave home only to buy essential items such as food and medicine. In all these cases the health recommendations for controlling the corona should be fully followed. Curfew permits issued by police officers are valid only if drivers and occupants of vehicles are wearing face shields.

The curfew will be enforced in all districts except Colombo, Kalutara, Gampaha and Puttalam from 8.00 pm to 5.00 am until Wednesday, May 06. The curfew will be enforced in these districts from 8.00 pm on Wednesday, May 06 and will remain in force till 5.00 am on Monday, May 11.
