Social Distancing

During the curfew and the lockdown on account of COVID-19 epidemic offices, commercial and private establishments, transport services, hospitality services & educational institutions etc. have been ordered to remain closed. However, offices and establishments dealing with essential services have been exempted and allowed to operate with the condition that social distancing norms would be strictly observed.

2. It is accordingly reiterated that the staff and employees engaged in providing essential services would maintain a distance of atleast 2-meters from each other as well as from their clients. Similarly the clients/customers and beneficiaries of the essential services shall maintain a distance of 2 meters among themselves.

It is therefore necessary that markings with 2-meter distance be put up in front of such establishments so as to ensure that customers and clients comply with the social distancing norms.
