Notice Regarding the arrival for foreigners

artment of W Kathmandu,

The Government of Nepal (GoN), as per the decision of 9th November, 2020, has decided to extend the shutdown of all the entry/exit points at the International border till 15th December 2020 and provisioned the following conditions for the foreigner's arrival to Nepal:

- 1. All the travellers must have a COVID-19 Negative Report (RT-PCR /Gene Xpert /True NAAT or equivalent) obtained within 72 hours prior to their departure from first port of call bound to Nepal. Children below 5 years are exempted of submitting PCR report if their accompanied parents have a negative Report of COVID-19.
- 2. All the Foreigners (excluding the ones who work at the diplomatic missions in Nepal, International organizations, INGOs, Nepali Origin Non-resident Nepalese (NRNs) and their family members) should obtain a pre-approval/recommendation letter from GoN (Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Home Affairs or Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation or Nepali Diplomatic Missions abroad) for ensuring arrival permission and on-arrival visa at any entry point of Nepal.
