DIRECTION – DESIGNATED CHARTER FLIGHTS -CONDITION OF ENTRY

I, Commissioner David Manning, Controller, by virtue of the National Pandemic Act 2020, hereby issue the following Direction:

As a condition of entry into Papua New Guinea (PNG) and to effectively monitor designated charter flights that coordinate the arrival of large numbers of foreign workers into PNG at the one time, incoming passengers will be required to be fitted with a GPS tracking ankle bracelet (upon arrival) for the designated quarantine period.

The cost shall be borne by the relevant passengers/companies for the period of quarantine.

This direction is to take effect immediately, commencing with an Air Niugini charter flight carrying 152 foreign workers and arriving in Port Moresby on 13 October, 2020 (PX9089).

The designation of a charter flight for this direction is made by the Controller of the National Pandemic Act, 2020 or his delegate.

Any failure to comply with this direction is an offence under the *Emergency (General Provisions) (COVID 19) Act 2020*. Non-Compliance with this direction can result in a fine not exceeding K50,000.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years.
