





REVISED TIMELINE FOR PUBLIC ACTIVITIES – 04 OCTOBER 2020 TO 31 OCTOBER 2020

Considering the current epidemiological situation in the Country, a revised timeline is presented herewith from 4th October 2020 to 31st October 2020. All activities would have to strictly follow the new normal behaviours. General Measures would apply to all functions listed. The situation will be reviewed regularly as appropriate based on epidemiological information. This timeline is not applicable for areas considered as high risk and are under lockdown.

The timeline below is coded as follows;

	Black – No operations
	Red – Higher restrictions (service providers and/or the recipients to be restricted to less than 50% of capacity with strong adherence to DREAM)
	Blue – Restricted (service providers and/or the recipients to be restricted to less than 75% of capacity with strong adherence to DREAM)
	White – Normal operations with strong adherence to DREAM

Table 2: Detailed description of the instructions to public – 04.10.2020 to 31.10.2020

Public activity / service category		Instructions
Transport	Public transport	Only allowed to transport passengers up to the seating capacity of the bus/train
	Private taxi services	Ensure the maximum number of passengers is limited two for cars and trishaws. For other types of vehicles, it should be limited to 50% of the seating capacity.
	Service delivery	Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given.
Government Offices		Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given.
Private sector offices and other (formal)	Supermarkets	1.5m ² of available walking space can be considered as adequate for 1 person. A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Shopping Malls	1.5m ² of available walking space can be considered as adequate for 1 person inside the individual shops. For shops: A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given. Gatherings and entertainment in the mall premises are not allowed.
	Financial institutions (banks, finance companies, pawning centres etc)	A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Clothing/textile shops	1.5m ² of available walking space should be considered as adequate for 1 person. A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Agriculture based	Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given.
Private/ Other	Grocery	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Open market/fairs	A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Economic centres	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Bakery	A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Street vendors	Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given

	Barber and Beauty Salons	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Furniture, Electrical, Hardware stores	A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Laundry	A maximum of 75% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Tailors and dressmakers	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Communication/ photocopy shops	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
Law enforcement	Courts	Can function at a maximum of 50% of the total seating capacity of the courtroom adhering to the instructions given.
	Prison	No visitors are allowed.
Health sector	Government Hospitals	Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given

	Funerals	Taking all possible precautions to minimize the number attending to less than 50% of the capacity of the premises adhering to the instructions given.
	Parties/events/ (indoor)	Not allowed
	Parties/events (outdoor)	Not allowed
	Public gatherings	Not allowed
	Places of worship	No collective activities or gatherings (except for weddings) as per the instructions given. Number of devotees at a given time should be restricted to 50% of the capacity of the premises, with a maximum of 50 people at any given time and strictly adhering to the instructions given.
	Boarding houses	Can remain at full capacity adhering to the instructions given. However no new persons should be given accommodation.
Recreation	Gymnasiums, indoor sports halls	Can function up to 50% of the capacity of the gymnasium or the hall adhering to the instructions given.
	Walkways	Open for public use adhering to the instructions given
	Cinemas, theatres	Closed
	Children's parks	Number of visitors to be restricted to 50% of the total capacity adhering to the instructions given
	Carnivals, musical shows, beach parties	Not allowed
	Swimming pools	Number of users of the swimming pool to be restricted 50% of the total capacity adhering to the instructions given.

Entertainment	Restaurant (dining in)	A maximum of 50% of the total seating capacity can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.
	Restaurant (take away/delivery)	Can function at full capacity adhering to the instructions given
	Pubs and bars	Closed

	Day rooms and home stays	Closed
	Hotels, rest houses and guest houses	Can function at less than 50% of the capacity adhering to the instructions given
