

### NOTIFICATION

As per the unlocking notification issued by Samdrup Jongkhar COVID-19 Taskforce vide notification No. SDA/COVID-19/Secretariat/2020-21/998 dated 20/9/2020, the schools for classes IX-XII and NFECs/CLCs will be re-opened on 28/09/2020 following *New Normal Mode*. Therefore, the schools, students, parents, and relevant stakeholders are required to kindly note and comply with the following:

1. Schools to ensure and follow COVID-19 preventive protocols stringently. To this effect, schools to practice mandatory hand washing with soaps, use of face masks, physical distancing and scanning of Druk Trace QR code with effective monitoring and reporting mechanism.
2. Schools to maintain inventory of day students with travel history of their parents and family members in order to ascertain the vulnerability of COVID-19 risks.
3. Schools to implement prioritized curriculum as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Education.
4. All students (classes IX-XII) residing in Samdrup Jongkhar town will have to undergo mandatory one week facility quarantine and get tested for COVID-19 on RT-PCR. Their joining of schools will be subject to confirming negative on RT-PCR tests.
5. All students (classes IX-XII) residing in the areas falling under the urban zones of Jomotsangkha, Samdrupcholing and Dewathang will have to get mandatory RT-PCR tests for COVID-19 without having to undergo facility quarantine.
6. Schools receiving students from Samdrup Jongkhar town must verify COVID-19 test results of the students on their reporting to schools and follow other measures of COVID-19 preventive protocols. This will also apply to the students coming from the areas falling under the urban zones of Jomotsangkha, Samdrupcholing and Dewathang who have been tested for COVID-19.
