Public Notification

In line with the press release on extension of nationwide lockdown from the Prime Ministers's Office dated 29 December 2020, the Sarpang Covid-19 Task Force hereby notifies the public that the current lockdown 2.0 is *extended until 2 January 2021*. This is to discourage gathering of people, which could otherwise heighten the risk of the disease spread due to impending new year and Nyilog celebrations.

Further, as we extend the current lockdown, in addition to the earlier public notifications issued vide SD-COVID-19/07/2020-2021/177 and SD-COVID-19/07/2020-2021/175 both dated 23 December 2020, the Task Force would like to inform the general public on the following:

1. The movements of orange carrying vehicles within the Dzongkhag will be allowed till 9:00pm with effect from 30 December 2020. The owners of the orange shall be allowed to travel along with the drivers of the orange transporting vehicles.
2. Orange exporter/transporters shall arrange additional vehicles for escorts from Darachu and Tamala at 07:00am in the morning and 02:00pm in the afternoon to enhance the frequency of the orange transportation from source to the orange export depot.
3. Orange loaded vehicles will be allowed to exit till 06:00pm from the border check post.
4. Movements of orange pickers from orchard to orchard within the same Gewog shall be allowed.
