Joint Announcement - The Prime Minister's Office and the **Ministry of Health:**

In the explanation to this resolution, it is stated that in light of the expected lapse of the state of emergency on account of the Coronavirus (on September 6th, 2020) and in light of the fact that a real risk still remains for the extensive spread of the coronavirus and for significant harm to the public's health and that this risk necessitates the continuation of the legally-sanctioned actions, it was decided to ask the Knesset's Constitution, Law and Justice Committee to extend the proclamation of a state of emergency due to the coronavirus by sixty additional days, starting at September 7th, 2020 until November 6th, 2020.
