An announcement on behalf of Major General (Reserve) Roni Numa:

As part of the provisions of the capsule settlement between the yeshivas and the ultra-orthodox desk, coronavirus tests were carried out. Anyone tested positive or required to self-isolate will not be returning home after Yom Kippur and will be staying in specially-designated "coronavirus yeshivas" or "follow-up yeshivas." Yeshiva students who will test negative will be released to their homes.

In yeshivas that do not operate according to the capsule settlement, we intend to carry out tests on Tuesday and Wednesday. Until the tests results are in, the yeshiva students should not be released to their homes.
