Pending two negative COVID-19 test results

The Minister of Health Mr. Yuli (Yoel) Edelstein instructed to shorten the isolation period to 10 days pending two negative COVID-19 tests in light of the recommendation of healthcare professionals; effective Tuesday 15.12.20 at 8:00 AM:

- The first test must be conducted at the start of the isolation period
- The second test must be conducted on the 9th day from the date of contact

It is important to note that the minimum time between the first and second test must be at least 24 hours.

You can make an appointment for a COVID-19 test at the HMOs, there is no need for a doctor's referral, you can also get tested at the drive-in testing centers.
