The Ministerial Committee for Coping with Coronavirus approved tonight (Monday, by telephone survey) the extension of the mandatory coronavirus tests requirement for inbound passengers to Israel. This requirement states that anyone must take a coronavirus test up to 72 hours before the time of departure to Israel, as well as another test upon arrival in Israel, at the border passage point.

This requirement is extended through Tuesday, 4.5.2021.
