**DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002: AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS ISSUED IN
TERMS OF SECTION 27(2)**

I, Dr Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma, Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, designated under section 3 of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002), having declared a national state of disaster, published in Government Gazette No. 43096, Government Notice No. 313 of 15 March 2020, and extended by Government Notices Nos. 646 of 5 June 2020, 765 of 13 July 2020, 889 of 15 August 2020, 995 of 14 September 2020 and 1090 of 14 October 2020, hereby in terms of section 27(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002, after consultation with the relevant Cabinet members, make the Regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE**Definitions**

1. In these Regulations, "the Regulations" means the regulations published by Government Notice No. R. 480 of 29 April 2020 as amended by Government Notices Nos. R. 608 of 28 May 2020, R. 714 of 25 June 2020, R. 763 of 12 July 2020, R. 846 of 31 July 2020, R. 891 of 17 August 2020, No. 999 of 18 September 2020, No. 1011 of 20 September 2020 and No. 1053 of 1 October 2020.

Amendment of regulation 75 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 75 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for subregulation (1) of the following subregulation:

"(1) The 18 land borders which were partially operational, will be fully operational, and the 35 land borders which were closed, will remain closed except for the Sani Pass border post which will reopen on 22 October 2020."

Amendment of Table 4 of the Regulation

3. Table 4 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for item 3 of the following item:

"3. The 34 land borders that remain closed."

Commencement

4. This amendment to the Regulations will come into operation on 22 October 2020.
