

Precautionary and Preventive Measures During the Blessed Month of Ramadan



- Distributing Iftar (break a fast) meals for fasting people is banned inside or in front of restaurants, and distribution is limited to residential labor complexes.
- Selling at restaurants to public is restricted to regular meals, by following the utmost precautionary and preventive measures.
- Gatherings are not allowed while receiving Iftar meals. Keep a distance of 2 meters between persons, and adhere to wearing protective masks.












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- Iftar (break a fast) tents or allocating public places for shared meals are banned.
- Distributing Iftar meals to fasting people in front of homes is banned. Those wishing to need to coordinate with competent authorities.
- Attention should be paid by restaurants to the need of ensuring hygiene, safety and health of cookers and service providers, and their commitment to wearing masks and gloves.
- Iftar meals should be in boxes or bags that are tightly closed.
