Since the onset of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the government, under the leadership of the President of the Republic, His Excellency Faure Essozimna GNASSINGBE, has enacted several measures intended to contain the risk of the virus spreading.

The government, on the basis of the evolution of the epidemic and the progress reports of the Scientific Council, has proceeded to successive reductions in the curfew. The new reports drawn up by the Scientific Council confirm the trend towards stabilization of the epidemic. Consequently, the government decides as of Tuesday 09 June 2020:

- 1. the total lifting of the curfew;
- 2. the lifting of the closure of the towns initially concerned;
- 3. the wearing of protective mask compulsory for all.

The lifting of these provisions hardly means the end of the epidemic of the coronavirus (COVID-19) in our country.

Also, the government urges the entire population to continue to respect individual and collective prevention and protection measures (wash their hands with soap, use gel or hydro-alcoholic solution, do not shake hands. hands while

greeting each other, avoid hugs and hugs, etc.) to prevent the spread of disease.
