Only one point was on the agenda the pandemic to the new coronavirus (COVID-19).

The Government, after analyzing **the pandemic with the new coronavirus** (COVID-19) in the world, in particular in West Africa, and in order to contain the risk of the spread of the virus, decides, at this stage, on the following measures:

1. Suspension for two weeks from Friday March 20, 2020 of all air links from high-risk countries, namely: Italy, France, Spain and Ger: namely;

- 2. Cancellation of all international events planned in Togo for three weeks, as of this day March 16, 2020;
- 3. Suspension of non-essential official missions to high-risk countries, effective March 16, 2020;
- 4. compulsory 14-day self-isolation for anyone arriving in Togo and having stayed in a high-risk country. In the event of non-compliance with self-isolation, strong penalties are provided for;
- 5. The Government advises against traveling to countries where the pandemic is rife;
- Prohibition of any gathering of more than 100 people throughout the national territory, for one month, from Thursday March 19,
 2020 at midnight;
- 7. Strengthening surveillance and individual and collective prevention and protection measures: washing hands with soap, using hydro-alcoholic gel, not shaking hands when greeting each other, avoiding hugs and hugs, etc.
- 8. For urgent actions, the Government releases the sum of two (02) billion FCFA;
- 9. It also urges the administrative, traditional, military and religious authorities, and the entire population to contribute to the application of these measures which are binding on **all.**
