

INDEPENDENT STATE OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA NATIONAL PANDEMIC ACT 2020

OFFICE OF THE CONTROLLER NO. 11 NATIONAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- I, Commissioner David Manning, Controller, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020* and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the following measures:
- 1. 25-30 seater public transport vehicles may continue to operate during if passenger numbers are limited to 15 passengers.
- 2. All other public transport vehicles, including vessels may continue to operate but only if passenger numbers are limited to 5 less than the vehicle licensed capacity.
- 3. Taxis may operate but only if passenger numbers are limited to 2.
- 4. All persons on public transport including the driver and passengers must at all times while on the public transportation wear a mask of face covering in compliance with the requirements in Measure 10.
- 5. Private transportation may continue to operate, including but not limited to hotel and security transportation.
- 6. An individual or organisation who fails to adhere to the Measure shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the National Pandemic Act 2020.

- 7. Any vehicle found to be transporting persons in breach of paragraphs 1, 2, 3, or 4 by an authorised officer shall be impounded by an Authorised officer for the period of the Pandemic or at an earlier date as issued by the Controller or relevant Provincial Police Commander.
- 8. Non-compliance with this Measure should be reported to an authorised officer or the Provincial Police Commander.
- 9. Any Authorised Officer(s) appointed by the Controller pursuant to the Act, shall carry out and enforce the measures accordingly.
- 10. These Measure come into effect on 13 May 2021, and shall apply until the end of the Declaration of a pandemic under the Act, or as varied or revoked by the Controller.
