PUBLIC NOTICE

NaCOVERC therefore alerts the general public to these unacceptable happenings which may demotivate our personnel and imperil our COVID-19 Response; and to advise that those who choose to discountenance any of the COVID-19 regulations, will be doing so at their own peril.

Let it be known that law enforcement officials have clear and unequivocal directives to ensure that everybody fully complies with the measures introduced from time to time to contain COVID-19.
