

Road Traffic (COVID-19 Sanitary Measures) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 198 of the Road Traffic Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Road Traffic (COVID-19 Sanitary Measures) (Amendment) Regulations 2021**.

2. In these regulations –

“principal regulations” means the Road Traffic (COVID-19 Sanitary Measures) Regulations 2021.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definition –

“Temporary Restrictions of Movement Order 2021” means the Order made by the Prime Minister under section 3 of the Quarantine Act 2020;

4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended –

(a) by revoking paragraph (1) and replacing it by the following paragraph –

(1) No person, other than a person who –

(a) is, pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Temporary Restrictions of Movement Order 2021, authorised to be outdoor; or

(b) holds a Work Access Permit,

shall travel in a bus or taxi during the peak hours of 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 8 p.m. on week days.

(b) in paragraph (2), by revoking subparagraph (b) and replacing it by the following subparagraph –

(b) Paragraph (a) shall not apply to a senior citizen who –

(i) is, pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Temporary Restrictions of Movement Order 2021, authorised to be outdoor; or

(ii) holds a Work Access Permit.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 April 2021.
