
Epi-surveillance Updates

2/06/2020

• HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- Twenty-six (26) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are returnees from South Africa (22), Botswana (3), and one (1) local case who are all isolated. The local case is contact of a known confirmed case.
- The cases for Manicaland Province were double reported by one (1) case, giving a cumulative of nine (9). Therefore the correct cumulative number of cases as confirmed by the line list is eight (8) cases.
- Today 789 RDT screening tests and 637 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 46 021 (28 112 RDT and 18 709 PCR).
- To date the total number of confirmed cases is 203; recovered 29, active cases 170 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.


DISTRIBUTION OF CASES BY PROVINCE






COVID-19 EPICURVE 20 March to 1 June 2020
