In light of the current infection rate that continues to be low across the country, relaxation restrictions has been approved regarding outdoor masking requirements.

The Ministry of Health Director General amended the Public's Health Ordinance and effective tomorrow, 18.4.2021 there will be no masking requirements outdoors.

This means that one is now permitted to go outdooes without wearing a mask, as well as in one's personal living area.

It should be stressed that the Ministry of Health guidance concerning the masking requirement in outdoor gatherings remains unchanged.

The masking requirement also remains unchanged for indoors. The Ministry of Health reminds the public that everyone must take a mask with them when going out as it will be required for indoor stay and to follow the masking, distancing and hygiene practices, for the sake of everyone's health.
