



# Travelling to the Netherlands

## Checklist for travel



Foreign tourists travelling from safe countries with a low COVID-19 risk are welcome in the Netherlands.



Travelling from another country? Check if the EU entry ban applies to you.



Travelling from an area with a high COVID-19 risk? You must show a negative test result and self-quarantine for 10 days upon arrival in the Netherlands. Quarantine is mandatory for travellers coming from very high-risk areas.

## Basic rules



Wash your hands thoroughly and regularly.



Stay 1.5 metres away from other people.



COVID-19 symptoms? Stay at your holiday accommodation and get tested as soon as possible.



Positive COVID-19 test? You must self-isolate for 10 days.

## Reopening plan

The government is reopening society step by step. From Saturday 5 June, most places in the Netherlands will be open, subject to certain conditions.
