Decree 82/2021, of 17-3-2021 extending [Decree 45/2021](#) , of 17 February 2021, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

Statement of reasons

The stabilization of the indicators related to the infection caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus allowed certain flexibility days ago in the measures established to preserve public health and guarantee the viability of our healthcare system.

When the time has come to weigh the incidence of these measures, the indicators of the pandemic's impact do not allow at this time to ease them, and it is necessary to extend them all with the same purpose. Consequently, with the publication of this Decree, the measures adopted by [Decree 45/2021](#) , of 17-2-2021, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS coronavirus, are extended for one more week -CoV-2, with the modifications approved by [Decree 59/2021](#) , of February 24, 2021, [Decree 67/2021](#), of March 3, 2021, and [Decree 73/2021](#) , of March 10, 2021.

For everything that has been presented, at the proposal of the Minister of Health, the Government, in the session of March 17, 2021, approves this Decree with the following content:

Single item. Extension of exceptional measures

[Decree 45/2021](#) , of 17-2-2021, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, is extended until March 24, 2021 , with the approved modifications by [Decree 59/2021](#) , of February 24, 2021, [Decree 67/2021](#) , of March 3, 2021, and [Decree 73/2021](#) , of March 10, 2021.

Final provision

This Decree enters into force on March 18, 2021.
