Decree 124/2021, of 21-4-2021 extending [Decree 93/2021](#) , of 24-3-2021 of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

Statement of reasons

Although the measures adopted by the Government in the context of the pandemic and the administration of more than 20,000 doses of the vaccine against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus have allowed the numbers of new infections to stabilise, it has been detected a certain pressure due to the appearance of new outbreaks, which is why it is not yet possible to relax the measures taken to contain the rate of infections.

Consequently, in order to be able to continue guaranteeing the viability of the health system and relieve hospital pressure, through the publication of this Decree, the measures adopted by Decree 93/2021, of 24-3-2021, are extended for another week exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, with the modifications approved by [Decree 100/2021](#) , dated 3-31-2021, and [Decree 117/2021](#) , dated 4-14 -2021.

For everything that has been presented, at the proposal of the Minister of Health, the Government, in the session of April 21, 2021, approves this Decree with the following content:

Single item. Extension of exceptional measures

[Decree 93/2021](#) , of 24-3-2021 of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, is extended until April 28, 2021 , with the approved modifications by [Decree 100/2021](#) , dated 3-31-2021, and [Decree 117/2021](#) , dated 4-14-2021.

This Decree enters into force on April 22, 2021
