Decree 325/2022, of 3-8-2022, extending Decree 260/2022, of 22-6-2022, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

Statement of reasons

Since the evolution of the epidemiological data remains stable and does not put the population or the health system at risk, the preventive measures in force can be maintained for another two weeks.

The Government's intervention is based on the provisions of the General Health Law, of March 20, 1989, and of Law 31/2021, of November 22, a consolidated text classified as public security.

In this context, the extension is established, until August 17, 2022, of the measures adopted by Decree 260/2022, of 22-6-2022, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, extended by Decree 271/2022, of 6-29-2022; by Decree 279/2022, of 7-6-2022; by Decree 290/2022, of 7-13-2022; by Decree 302/2022, of 20-7-2022, and by Decree 319/2022, of 27-7-2022, which may be modified depending on the evolution of the pandemic.

For everything that has been presented, at the proposal of the Minister of Health, the Government, in the session of August 3, 2022, approves this Decree with the following content:

Single item. Extension of exceptional measures

Decree 260/2022, of 22-6-2022, of new exceptional measures due to the evolution of the health emergency situation caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, is extended until August 17, 2022, extended by Decree 271/2022, of 6-29-2022; by Decree 279/2022, of 7-6-2022; by Decree 290/2022, of 7-13-2022; by Decree 302/2022, of 20-7-2022, and by Decree 319/2022, of 27-7-2022.

Final provision

This Decree enters into force on August 4, 2022.
