

Public Notification on Home Quarantine

SC19TF would like to inform the Residents of Phuentsholing that individuals wishing to travel to Low Risk Areas can now register for mandatory home quarantine of 7 days. The following protocols are to be followed:

1. Travelers shall register for home quarantine using the following link:

2. Helpline shall advise the travelers for testing and upon receipt of the test result, the travelers can register for ePass using following link:
3. The travelers shall upload the test result, whether positive or negative, on their ePass registration

Note:

1. Traveler shall not be allowed to come out of his/her house during the entire quarantine period.
2. All travelers shall be tested at the flu clinics one day before entering into home quarantine.
3. If the result of any traveler turns out to be positive on the day zero, he/she shall be advised for home isolation for 7 days and allow to travel without test on day 7.
4. On day 7 of their quarantine period, 10% of the travelers who tested negative during the day zero shall be randomly tested. If the travelers test positive, their quarantine duration shall be extended by 7 more days.
5. Gewog focal persons shall facilitate the registration, testing and transportation of travelers from rural and peri-urban areas.
6. Home quarantine shall be cancelled for any breach of the home quarantine protocols and the quarantine duration shall be extended by 7 more days.
7. For any emergencies, the travelers shall call helpline (112, 1010, 5555) and for any medical emergencies, teleconsultation and delivery of medicines, call mobile medical team directly.
8. Travelers requiring assistance for the registration and ePass may call helpline (1010/5555).
