URGENT NOTICE

As per the decision of Government of Nepal (Council of Ministers) made on 23rd December 2021 regarding gradual spread of New variant of COVID-19 (Omicron), provisions for passengers travelling to Nepal shall be as follows.

Passengers travelling to Nepal from South Africa, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Namibia, Lesotho, Swatini, Mozambique, Malawi and Hong Kong as first port of embarkation or transit or with the travel history of such countries within the past three weeks are restricted from 2nd December 2021. Airline shall ensure that such passengers do not board their aircraft flying to Nepal

Notwithstanding the provision as mentioned above, Nepali passport holders, foreign officials holding diplomatic passport or official passport or residential visa of Nepal travelling from the countries with the risk of COVID-19 are permitted to enter into Nepal subject to following conditions:

- Passengers with no symptom similar to COVID-19, who have completed 14 days of full vaccination and are with Negative PCR test report obtained within last 72 hours, are permitted to enter into Nepal subject to 10 days' home quarantine.
- Nepali nationals who are not fully vaccinated or vaccinated within last 14 days are permitted to enter into Nepal subject to Antigen test at the entry point. Such passengers, if tested positive, shall be subjected to institutional isolation, while passengers with negative report are permitted subject to 10 days' home isolation.
- If the foreign nationals holding diplomatic passport, official passport and residential visa of Nepal are not fully vaccinated or vaccinated within last 14 days, they are permitted to enter into Nepal subject to Antigen test at the entry point. Such passengers, if tested positive, shall be subjected to institutional isolation or home isolation under the responsibility of concerned agency/entity. The others with Negative report are allowed subject to 10 days of hotel quarantine or 10 days of home quarantine under the responsibility of diplomatic mission.
