COVID-19 personal protective equipment (PPE)

<u>A brief visit</u>, e.g., give medicine, food, fluids, turn in bed, fix a remote etc.

Resident has MINOR symptoms. No fever, slight cough and little phlegm:

Just a FFP2 (viral mask) is needed - wash hands or use alcohol rub before and <u>after</u> entering the area



A brief visit, e.g., give medicine, food, fluids, turn in bed, fix a remote etc.

Resident has MAJOR symptoms. Fever, weakness, cough and a lot of phlegm:

Just a FFP2 (viral mask) and goggles/facial shield is needed - wear



gloves if you need to touch body fluids, wash/alcohol rub your hands before and <u>after</u> entry

Long visit, e.g. help with ADL, urine/faeces, bathing etc.

FULL PPE GEAR; viral mask, goggles/shield, gloves and gown -

wash/alcohol rub your hands before entry, after taking off gloves and <u>after</u> leaving the room



P.S. THERE IS NEVER THE NEED FOR DONNING 2 PAIR OF GLOVES AT THE SAME TIME – HAIRNET or hat is NOT NEEDED – NEVER USE BLUE PLASTIC SHOES OVER SHOES
