Covid-19 and contact tracing

Covid-19 is no longer classified as generally dangerous. However, infection tracing will still take place in in-patient care where there are people at high risk of becoming seriously ill.

Advice and recommendations

Stay home if you are ill and have symptoms of Covid-19

Stay home and avoid close contact with others if you are ill with symptoms of Covid-19.

Vaccination

People over 50 and people in risk groups are recommended to get vaccinated.

Special advice to those not vaccinated

Adults who are not vaccinated should be particularly careful. Those who are not vaccinated and belong to a medical risk group, run a higher risk of getting seriously ill with Covid-19. The risk of serious illness increases with age.
